My comprehensive psychological/psychoeducational evaluations include the following:

- in-person testing at my office in Caldwell for approximately 6-8 hours (can be broken up into multiple sessions)
- parent and child/client interviews
- teacher, school counselor, and/or private tutor interviews if warranted
- private therapist and/or psychiatrist interviews if warranted
- child developmental history questionnaire
- review of records
- cognitive testing to examine ability
- academic skills assessment to examine reading, phonological skills, writing, math, oral expression, and listening comprehension
- ADHD/executive functioning evaluation
- learning disabilities evaluation
- dyslexia testing if warranted
- autism evaluation if warranted
- online questionnaires for parent, child, and one or two teachers to examine social/emotional/behavioral/executive functioning and attention (depending on age)
- 60-80 page comprehensive report with detailed recommendations for home, school/college, and standardized testing (if applicable): First 10-15 pages are summary of strengths, diagnoses, and recommendations
- 1-1/2 hour virtual feedback session where I review the findings of the report with parents/older teen client
- separate 1/2 hour virtual feedback session where I review the findings with the child in child-friendly language, if applicable

My current fee for this evaluation is \$5400. I am out-of-network with insurance, but can supply a Superbill. Insurance may not reimburse for learning evaluations (such as dyslexia or learning disabilities), but may partially reimburse for diagnoses like ADHD and ASD. If interested, I recommend clients call their insurance company for more information about possible partial reimbursement--I'd be happy to provide a list of questions to ask. **I also offer lower cost evaluations if, after reviewing recent CST evaluations or considering the reason for referral, I feel confident that I can provide a proper evaluation with less testing.**

If you are only looking for a dyslexia evaluation (and not a comprehensive evaluation to evaluate other areas), the cost is lower at \$2520 and includes:

- in-person dyslexia testing at my office in Caldwell for approximately 3-4 hours
- parent and child interviews
- teacher, school counselor, and/or private tutor interviews if warranted
- private therapist and/or psychiatrist interviews if warranted
- child developmental history questionnaire
- review of records
- comprehensive report with detailed recommendations for home, school/college, and standardized testing (if applicable)
- virtual feedback session where I review the findings of the report
